*Empowering Sustainability Through Education*

The year 2025 marked an intense and meaningful period for Gaialux asbl, characterised by educational actions, artistic engagement, public outreach and strong partnerships around the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). From awareness campaigns and publications to exhibitions, workshops and participatory projects with youth, students and the wider public, Gaialux fostered spaces for dialogue, creativity and collective reflection on the ecological and social challenges of our time.

Key actions included:

- Awareness-raising campaigns, publications, exhibitions, workshops and public events, developed in close cooperation with local, national and European partners. Flagship initiatives such as the [I.D.E.E. exhibition](#) and the launch of the [I.D.E.E. en Action](#) project strengthened Gaialux's educational approach by integrating science reflection, artistic expression and experiential learning, with a strong focus on youth engagement and capacity-building.
- The association also reinforced its involvement in European frameworks and networks, notably through its active role within the EU Climate Pact and the preparation and implementation of [Erasmus+ projects Allez l'Éco](#).
- Gaialux also actively engaged in community-based events, such as the [LUGA festival](#) and the Social Inclusion Festival of Mamer, strengthening its outreach to the wider public and fostering dialogue on sustainability and inclusion at local level.

- The year was further characterised by increased institutional recognition, including official authorisation to host volunteering positions and the establishment of new strategic partnerships with educational institutions, cultural actors and civil society organisations. These developments contributed to the organisation's operational stability and long-term vision.

## Looking Ahead – 2026

Building on the achievements of 2025, Gaialux will pursue a strategy of consolidation and growth in 2026. In the new year Gaialux will focus on:

- Scaling up existing flagship projects.
- Developing new collaborative initiatives, public events and awareness campaigns.
- Strengthening European cooperation and project sustainability.
- Enhancing long-term impact through partnerships and community-based approaches.

## Summary of Activities – 2025

### January 2025 – Awareness and Public Reflection

- **24 January – International Day of Education (SDG 4)**

On the occasion of the United Nations' International Day of Education, Gaialux launched a dedicated awareness campaign highlighting the importance of SDG 4 – Quality Education. The initiative was disseminated through social media channels, contributing to public outreach and engagement on education as a key driver of sustainable development.

- **1 March - Atelier Cartes Postales**

Gaialux launched the first Atelier Cartes Postales: the goal is to put together inspirational creative postcards with the guide of our artists. Nicole Trigatti is coordinating this initiative. Postcards allow for colourful creative expressions, guided by Gaialux on selected topic, together with thoughtful texts. They will be used to inspire part of the just started new project IDEE en Action. But they will also be the occasion to highlight the 10th year from the Paris Agreement and the launch of Agenda 2030 in the next autumn-winter. They could support a climate action - to be defined. - **18 - 19 March, annual EU Climate Pact Conference**

As an EU Climate Pact Ambassador, Gaialux took part in the annual conference, facilitating the session *“Drawing Solutions: Art and Comics for Climate Action”*, together with Gailux and Climate Pact Ambassador Lucia Bastarolo.

Gaialux also contributed to workshops on food waste and participated in the artistic performance *“Beny the Banana”*, a Climate Pact Choir narrating the environmental journey of a banana, directed by Bartu Elci Ozsoy.



- **April 2025 - Institutional Recognition and Project Launch**

Gaialux received official approval from the Luxembourgish government to host volunteering positions, with financial support from the **Service National de Jeunesse**.

Gaialux joined **CELL** for the **Earth Day** campaign.

The project **I.D.E.E. en Action**, funded by the **Fondation Sommer**, was officially approved and launched its first **somatic movement workshop** at EEL1 with students of Prof. Carla Coppola.



## May –June 2025 – Youth Engagement and Project Development

Gaialux joined the EU Commission's **Natura 2000 campaign**, organising a nature walk in the Vallée du Mamer and Eich with youth from the *Chrysalis of Cooperation Nord SD* project.

Launch of **I.D.E.E. en Action** at the **SOLINA Youth Center**.

Participation in *Culture Escape at Uni*, including a textile workshop and awareness campaign.

Invitation to the **LUGA opening ceremony**.

## October 2025 – Education, Gender Equality and Advocacy

- **October 2025 - Idee en Action at EEL1:**

A new cycle of workshops on the Agenda 2030, with a special focus on SDG 5 (Gender Equality), was implemented within the framework of the *I.D.E.E. en Action* project at the European School EEL1. The workshops are conducted during sociology classes taught by Prof. Daiva Tailiute. Students are introduced to the Sustainable Development Goals through a general overview, followed by interactive learning activities focused on the goals. A specific session is dedicated to SDG 5, organised on the occasion of the **Orange Week**, with particular

attention to Target 5.2. Students are then introduced to the concept of **advocacy campaigns** and are invited to design and develop their own campaigns on different topics, under the guidance of the project team. 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- **October 2025 – I.D.E.E. Exhibition at EEL1:**

The *I.D.E.E.* Exhibition was presented at EEL1, accompanied by a vernissage and public presentation by Gaialux, with the participation of the EU Climate Pact Coordinator for Luxembourg, two *I.D.E.E.*, *EEL1 secondary director*, I.D.E.E. artists and a delegation of students attending COP30.





## November 2025 – Inclusion and Community Engagement

- **November 2025:**

Gaialux participated in the Festival of Inclusion in Mamer, presenting selected works from the I.D.E.E. Exhibition focused on social SDGs and facilitating a textile workshop on SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities) in collaboration with Donatella Massoli (ForMe).
